Policies as approved at the Berks County Farm Bureau Banquet September 27, 2024

- 1. We recommend implementing a PMB-established premium per gallon of milk retailed in Pennsylvania, no less than 95% of the proceeds evenly distributed to all Pennsylvania producers per CWT shipped per year, regardless of where the milk was produced or processed.
- 2. We recommend deleting the following: that the name of the Pennsylvania Milk Marketing Board be changed to the Pennsylvania Milk Regulatory Board.
- 3. We recommend a PMB established premium that (1) distributes premium dollars uniformly per CWT among all Pennsylvania dairy products, (2) the amount charged to Pennsylvania consumers not be substantially more than is distributed back to Pennsylvania dairy farmers, and (3) the distributing system must not provide incentives to move raw milk across state lines to avoid the premium from reaching Pennsylvania dairy producers; and is not supported indefinitely in the event this cannot be achieved.
- 4. We recommend fewer regulations for farmers who want to do retail marketing of products from their own farms including raw milk.
- 5. We recommend that registration stickers on license plates be required.
- 6. We recommend that the YAP age be amended to 16-35. Under 18 would have a supervisor with the proper credentials.
- 7. We recommend increased funding to all the Centers of Excellence funded through the ag excellence line of the state budget.
- 8. We recommend there be a ban on certain foreign entities from owning agricultural land in PA (like Arkansas law).
- 9. We recommend any PMB premium decision be based partly on some PA dairy sector trends and local impact, such as national dairy statistical ranks and number of PA dairy farms trend.
- 10. We recommend there be a ban on certain foreign entities from owning agricultural land in the U.S.
