

### MERCER COUNTY FARM BUREAU AT BOARD AT WORK FOR YOU

Local legislatures are willing to hear how citizens feel about various issues in which they will be making decisions. When it comes to legislation that impacts agriculture, our elected officials need to receive input from farmers and others involved in agriculture to understand how their vote will affect the farming industry. To help legislatures to gain a deeper knowledge of agricultural issues and to avoid unintended consequences, six local representatives for Mercer Farm Bureau will be traveling to Harrisburg to meet with our elected officials. Bob and Sandy Craft, Sam Huff, Bill Canon, Larry Moose, and Donald Koontz will be attending the event in late March. The issues for action that are being discussed include:

- Funding for on-farm conservation measures
- State budget priorities
- Creation of a grain indemnity fund
- Whole milk in schools
- Relief from excessive storm water management fees
- Fairness for landowners with natural gas well

Last year, PFB was able to accomplish the creation of a broadband authority in PA, clarified the types of driver's license that farmers can use when operating trucks/ truck combinations over 26,000 pounds, protected farmers from agritourism lawsuits, and addressed issues in the tax code. Your membership keeps a voice for agriculture friendly laws alive.



AgriStress Help Line has staff who has received an additional 300 hours of training specific to farmers, ranchers, and farm workers. The help line is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and in 160 languages. It is sponsored by the Agri Safe National Network. More information is available on the PA Department of Ag website.
