Have You Renewed Your Membership?

Dues for 2021 membership in Mercer County Farm Bureau are \$75, which includes your membership in Pennsylvania Farm Bureau and American Farm Bureau Federation.

Be sure to pay dues before Dec. 31 to receive an increase in your Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance. A \$1,000 AD&D policy is part of your first year as a member. Each year that a member's dues are renewed before Dec. 31, the insurance value increases by \$100 to a maximum of \$3,300. Maintain your membership and pay your dues now. If you have not renewed your membership by Dec.31, the insurance will revert back to the \$1,000 limit.

This year's membership goal is 302 members. As of Dec. 17, MCFB had 243 members enrolled. You can help MCFB meet this membership goal. Invite a neighbor or friend to join Mercer County Farm Bureau. Reverse Parade Draws Thousands

Mercer County Farm Bureau participated in the Reverse Tractor and Tinsel Parade at the Stoneboro Fairgrounds. The event Dec. 5 that was to take place between the hours of 6 and 9 p.m. started early because of the traffic building up on Rt. 62 outside the gates. The last car pulled through the route at 11:45 p.m. People were excited to be able to celebrate the season in a safe way. Visitors donated over 2.5 tons of food items for Lakeview Area Helping Hands.

Some of PFB Legislative Accomplishments

The two-year legislative session has come to a close. Pennsylvania Farm Bureau has several pieces of legislation of concern to farmers and rural Pennsylvanians that became law during this session.

Two rural broadband bills became law. The first, Senate Bill 835 will create a \$5 million loan program within the Commonwealth Financing Authority to fund broadband infrastructure projects in underserved rural communities. The law also establishes a designated fund within state government to fund these projects including the ability for federal dollars to be used in that effort. This is the first time that PA has designated money for rural broadband projects. Two requirements of the legislation are: companies must provide 25% of the funds for the project and the project must be for underserved areas of the state.

The second piece of legislation passed was House Bill 2048 that will allow rural cooperatives to run broadband infrastructure on their existing electrical easements without having to renegotiate those lease agreements. This only applies to cases where the rural electric is running fiber optic cable or other lines between existing utility poles.

These two pieces of legislation taken together are the most significant rural broadband legislation taken in a decade.

Also, during this session, the 2019 PA Farm Bill was passed. The budgets have provided for the necessary program critical to agriculture. A new tax credit was established to assist new and beginning farmers.

Vehicle code changes were established to allow for wider farm equipment on the highways.

PFB and MCFB will continue to work diligently to insure that the interests of Pennsylvania agriculture is brought to the attention of Congress and the General Assembly.

It is time to put together entries for the PFB safety contests. This year may be just the year to have your kids and grandkids participate with so many of them studying at home.


Also, teachers, please look into these events for your students.




