Chester Delaware County Farm Bureau Scholarship Guidelines

The Chester Delaware County Farm Bureau is pleased to offer scholarship grants of up to \$1000.00 toward higher education of Chester County, Delaware County, and Philadelphia County college students or high school students pursuing a career in agriculture or an agriculture-related field. Only college upperclassmen students (sophomore, junior or senior) or High School students pursuing a career in agriculture or an agriculture-related field who previously have not received a Chester Delaware County Farm Bureau scholarship award may apply.

For College Students:

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- The applicant must be a college student whose parent(s) or guardian(s) reside in Chester County, Delaware County, or Philadelphia County.
- The applicant must be majoring in the field of agriculture or agriculture-related field at a two or four-year college or university on a full-time basis.
- Selection will be based on the applicant's record of scholastic achievement and extracurricular activities without regard to race, sex, religion, or financial need.
- The scholarship is non-renewable.
- The **application form must be accompanied by the applicant's transcript** showing grades.
- **Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application.** College professors, advisors, department heads, and/or community leaders must write the recommendation on an official letterhead.
- The **application form must be accompanied by a copy of the college Letter of Acceptance.**
- Selection of the recipients will be the responsibility of the Chester Delaware County Farm Bureau Board of Directors.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

For High School Students:

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- The applicant must be a High School Senior whose parent(s) or guardian(s) reside in Chester County, Delaware County, or Philadelphia County.
- The applicant must plan to major in the field of agriculture, or an agriculture-related field, at a two-year or four-year college or university on a full-time basis.
- Selection will be based on the applicant's record of scholastic achievement and extracurricular activities without regard to race, sex, religion, or financial need.
- The scholarship is non-renewable.

- The **application form must be accompanied by the applicant's transcript** showing grades and the applicant's SAT scores.
- **Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application.** High School Guidance Counselors, High School Teachers, and/or community leaders must write the recommendations.
- The **application form must be accompanied by a copy of the college Letter of Acceptance.**
- Selection of the recipients will be the responsibility of the Chester Delaware County Farm Bureau Board of Directors.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

PROCEDURES:

Scholarship Application and accompanying documents must be received on or before March 15, 2021

Personal interviews may be conducted.
