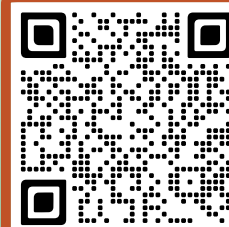

How We're Leading Together

- Advocating for continued and expanded **access to markets** through existing and new trade agreements.
- Working on legislation to exempt **wedding barns** from onerous local regulations.
- Fighting against excessive **stormwater management fees** at the municipal level.
- Advocating for the proper usage and placement of **solar**.
- Supporting legislation that allows local municipalities to **clean and maintain local waterways**.
- Advancing legislation and regulatory initiatives that address **agriculture's labor needs** and reforms the nation's **immigration system**.
- Advocating for the elimination or reform of the state's **property tax system**.
- Pushing for the U.S. Congress to allow unflavored and flavored **whole milk in schools**.
- Working with legislators to find solutions that address crop damage caused by wildlife and provide relief to farmers experiencing such losses.
- Advocating for common sense transportation reforms that make day to day life easier for those in all sectors of the agriculture industry.

Leading Together Gets Results

Pennsylvania agriculture is stronger because of PFB members leading together. Our members' advocacy has:

- **Preserved your right to farm** through one of the nation's strongest right to farm laws, state laws preempting local pesticide and fertilizer regulations, and the ACRE law protecting from restrictive local ordinances.
- **Delivered property tax relief** through establishing and updating the Clean and Green Act.
- **Saved you money** through sales tax exemptions for farm inputs, elimination of inheritance taxes on family farms and small businesses, reduction in the inheritance valuation for preserved farms, and REAP, which offers tax credits for conservation.
- **Protected your farm** through laws dealing with agricultural biosecurity trespass, stronger fines and penalties for hunting-related trespass, the new purple paint law to deter trespassing, limits on liability for equine, and landowner liability protections.
- **Eased burdensome regulations** through legal advocacy in Sackett v. EPA, enactment of statewide building code exemptions for agriculture, establishment of farm-friendly nutrient management laws, and creating stormwater management exemptions for high tunnels.
- **Improved transportation laws** through favorable laws that save farmers time and money, allowing movement of modern farm equipment on roadways, and a CDL exemption for farm vehicle drivers.
- **Protected the future of Pennsylvania agriculture** through the nation's leading farmland preservation program, the new Beginning Farmer Tax Credit, and the Agricultural Conservation Assistance Program (ACAP) to enhance local waterways.
- **Increased broadband service statewide** to ensure that rural communities can utilize this essential service.
- **Achieved civil liability reform laws** that protect agritourism businesses like corn mazes and pumpkin patches, from nuisance lawsuits.
