

Scholarships The CVF Scholarship is now in the hands of the Bridge **Builders Community** Foundation. Students can apply online from the last week of January to the first week of March.



We will be awarding two \$750 scholarships in 2025.

The foundation covers Venango, Clarion and Forest counties. Our criteria include: 1. Be a member or from a member household of the CVF Farm Bureau; 2. GPA of 2.0 or above; 3. AG Literacy Week. March 17-21


This year, CVF will be present in ten schoolrooms to read The Soil in Jackie's Garden by Peggy Thomas.
